- 1. Classical poetry (1 to 3 poems; not more than 50 lines)
- 2. Sonnet (1 to 3 poems; not more than 50 lines)
- 3. Free verses (1 to 3 poems; not more than 50 lines)
- 4. Theme : "My beautiful land"
- 5. Humorous poem or text (1 to 3 poems; not more than 50 lines or 4 pages)
- 6. Illustrated poem or text
- 7. Song (audio cassette or CD and text)
- 8. Japanese poems (haïku, tanka...)-(not more than 8 poems)
- 9. Geometric poem (enclosed in a drawing or a geometric form)
- 10. Tales and fables (not more than 4 pages)
- 11 Short story – novel (not more than 4 pages)
- 12. Short text or essay or letter (1 or 2 pages)
- 13. Children's stories and poems (3 poems or 4 pages- for adults)
- 14. Humanities (3 poems or 4 pages)
- 15. Published or unpublished book or selection (only 1 copy)
- 16. Collective youth works
- 17. Young poets category (to 16 years)
- 18. Young writers category (16 to 20 years)

RULES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Each entry is to be made in three (3) copies (only 1 for books, songs and illustrated works) without name or address,

just a personal number in top on the right, e.g. like : AB123

- For the "Song category" an audio cassette or CD and text
- Registration form
- 1 self addressed envelope

ENTRY FEE:
